As a result, in 2020, the council decided to act upon what was already known: Empty areas of the reservation calendar and unused reservations.

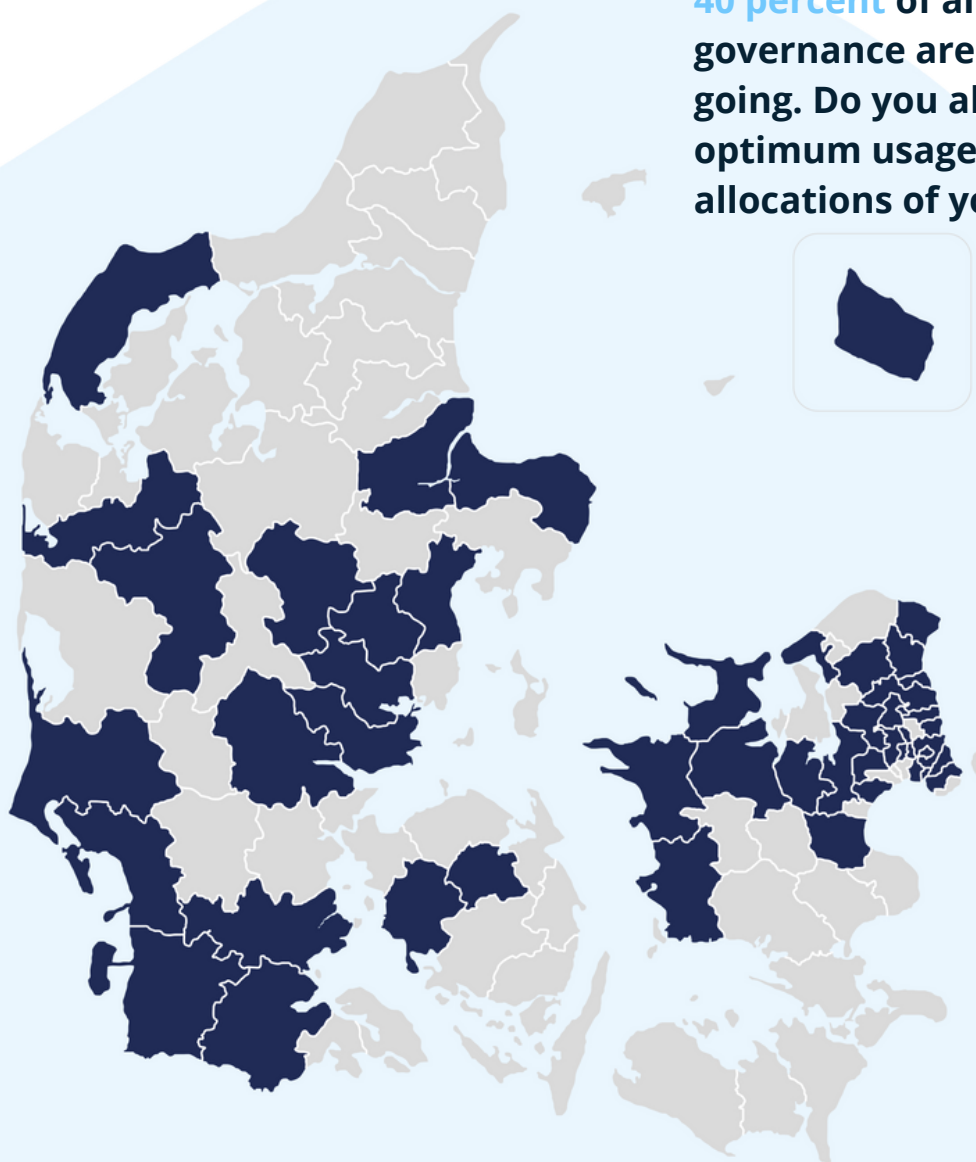
With concrete data, it took just a year to raise the usage rate with 10 percentage points.
